## SCRIPTURES

### June 12th –Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

**First Reading:** BECAUSE GOD WAS DISPLEASED WITH THE ACTIONS OF DAVID CONCERNING URIAH'S DEATH IN ORDER TO MARRY BATHSHEBA, GOD SENT NATHAN TO REPRIMAND DAVID. NATHAN REMINDS DAVID THAT GOD ANOINTED HIM KING OF ISRAEL AND VICTOR OVER SAUL. DAVID REALIZES HIS SIN AGAINST GOD, BUT NATHAN CONTINUES TO REVEAL TO DAVID THAT THE CHILD TO BE BORN TO HIM SHALL DIE. (2 SAMUEL 12: 7-10, 13)

**SECOND READING:** PAUL WRITES OF THE STRUGGLES BETWEEN GENTILES AND JEWS WHO BOTH NOW PROFESS BELIEF IN CHRIST JESUS. PAUL PROCLAIMS HIS LIFE IN CHRIST, WORKING TOWARDS UNITY AND FAITH IN THE SON OF GOD. ( GALATIANS 2:16,19-21)

**GOSPEL:** WHILE JESUS WAS DINING AT THE HOME OF A PHARISEE, A WOMAN OF THE CITY WHO WAS A SINNER, CAME AND ANOINTED HIS FEET WITH OIL. WEEPING, HER TEARS FELL UPON JESUS' FEET AND SHE DRIED THEM WITH HER HAIR. BECAUSE OF THE WOMAN'S RESPECT AND LOVE, JESUS FORGIVES HER SINS. THIS CAUSES THOSE PRESENT AT THE TABLE TO QUESTION WHO HE IS. (Luke 7: 36-8:3)

## TURNING TO GOD

It has become so easy to get distracted and pulled from our course, our focus. With the troubled times we are all faced with, coupled with our own trials and tribulations, we tend to forget to turn to God for help.

"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest...for my yoke is easy, and my burden light." Matthew 11:28-30 reaffirms to us that God's help is here for the taking when we are tired and overburdened, helpless and hopeless. As nations, communities and individuals struggling not only to keep true to religious, public and humanitarian obligations, the burden the Bible speaks of does not end here, but also includes the struggle of personal success, as we try to compete with the demands of the world today.

Through our faith, we can be assured that the good thoughts, deeds and decisions we make on a daily basis will bring us through our times of crisis, and in the end, will lead us ever closer to our destination-everlasting happiness for eternity in heaven.
